St Austell Town Council has 20 Councillors and was created following elections held in June 2009. Two full-time and one part-time staff have been recruited and the Council has made excellent progress in its first year or so of operation. The Council has supported the annual torchlight carnival which is proving to be a tremendous success. It has provided funding and support for a produce market, the new shop mobility scheme, Christmas lights, the Christmas late night shopping events and a number of environmental improvement projects. The Council's Planning Committee considers and responds to over 120 planning application consultations from Cornwall Council each year. A Communities Committee has also been formed which deals with grant applications for local community groups and organisations and oversees environmental projects.

Since the formation of the Council, Councillors have frozen the Town Council's element of the annual Council Tax charge at £31.82 (for Band D properties). This compares very favourably with the average Parish Council charge in Cornwall of £56.50 for Band D properties.
